You may not always need to be seen by a GP. We have 2 experienced ANP's who can see patients for minor ailments. Please see below:-

CAN SEE

- Headaches
- Ear problems
- Mouth problems (not dental)
- Nose problems
- Eye problems
- Cough/chest infections, respiratory concerns
- Muscular pains, joint pains
- Abdo pains UTI, Period issues, constipation, etc
- Diarrhoea and or vomiting
- Skin conditions/infections
- Follow up contraceptive advice, pill checks
- Child hood illness
- Gyne issues
- Sexual Health
- Parasitic infections
- Mental health
- Behavioural issues in children
- Patient who had accident/injury
- Wound care/dressings

Don't see

- On-going issues already been seen by Dr and waiting investigations
- Chest pains
- Follow-up from investigations i.e. scans bloods etc.
- Changes of medication, medication reviews
- Pregnancy related illness

Will see any age birth onwards. This list is not exhaustive if in doubt discuss with the Receptionist
